

Talking Points

Background: Democratic Candidate Lee Carter

Former marine, father and husband, community organizer and activist - particularly in the areas of affordable housing and worker protections.

Focus on helping others - from community service to supporting cancer care by working as a technician to repair oncology equipment.

Workers' candidate - advocate of campaign finance - has pledged to reject donations from for-profit corporate donors.

Why this Race Matters most:

We need an advocate for the interests of workers vs the incumbent's focus on profits of corporations and the wealthy.

Why Democrat Lee Carter?

- He will fight to raise the minimum wage, create more protections for workers, and support unions. Has pledged to reject donations from for-profit corporate donors.
- Advocates expanding Medicaid, which would bring healthcare benefits to 3100 individuals in District 50 along with numerous jobs in the healthcare sector
- Advocate for defending human rights, including protecting immigrants, LGBTQ, minorities, and women

Why NOT Republican incumbent Jackson Miller?

- Has sponsored and voted for legislation prohibiting cities from raising minimum wage.
- Voted to eliminate or reduce funding for clinics that provide health services for women and for services for at-risk youth and their families.
- Voted against Medicaid expansion and against health insurance coverage for children with autism.
